The Four Aces Club

The Four Aces Club started in 1966 in the entrance halls of the 1886 Dalston circus and theatre buildings. It became north London's legendary home of international black music and a second home to reggae sound systems including Count Shelly.

The club hosted acts such as *Stevie Wonder, Desmond Decker, Otis Redding* and *Billy Ocean. Bob Dylan* visited and *Bob Marley* ate curry goat there.

In the 1980s the *Four Aces* merged with a club in the main auditorium to become the legendary drum & bass and acid house venue *The Labyrinth* where *The Prodigy* made one of their first public appearances.
